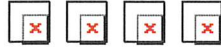

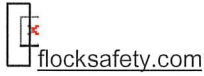

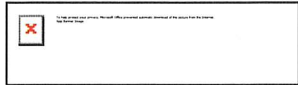

Good afternoon,

I am writing to share an important update we recently received from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) regarding equipment installations.

TxDOT has clarified that their existing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Texas DPS explicitly approves only License Plate Recognition (LPR) devices within the TxDOT Right of Way (ROW). At this time, devices capturing live video are not permitted in the TxDOT ROW for any law enforcement agency.

What does this mean for your agency?

- **Existing Installations:** If you currently have live video devices (Condor Fixed View, PTZ, or LPR bundles) already installed in a TxDOT ROW, no immediate action is required. These devices will remain in place. Should TxDOT change their policy regarding existing installations, we will proactively reach out to you.
- **Planned Installations:** If you have live video devices scheduled for installation in a TxDOT ROW, we will need to pivot to an alternative solution.

To keep your project moving forward, we recommend one of the following two options for your planned deployments:

1. **Relocation:** We can work together to identify a new location for the live video devices outside of the TxDOT ROW. If TxDOT eventually approves live video functionality in their ROW, we can discuss relocating the cameras back to your originally preferred sites.
2. **Conversion to LPR:** We can amend your contract to swap the planned live video devices for standard LPR devices at the TxDOT ROW locations. While this alters the specific functionality, it ensures you will still secure crucial static LPR captures in those key areas.



